| <p>Wk of April 5: Jesus Lives (Luke 24)</p> | <p>Read together Luke 24</p> | <p>Ask When the women told the disciples that Jesus was alive, did they believe them? What convinced them?</p> | <p>Practice memory verse: "Death is swallowed up in victory: 'O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?'" I Corinth. 15: 54-55</p> | <p>Ask Why was it important that so many people actually saw Jesus with their own eyes after he rose again?</p> | <p>PRAY "We thank you, God, for Jesus's glorious resurrection! Open our eyes to understand how the Bible points to what he has done for us. Amen."</p> |
| <p>Wk. of April 12: Who is My Neighbor (Luke 10)</p> | <p>Read together Luke 10</p> | <p>Ask Who were the three men who saw the wounded man on the road to Jericho? Which one helped the man? Why is that surprising?</p> | <p>Practice memory verse: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself." Luke 10:27</p> | <p>Ask What's the final question that Jesus asked the lawyer? If we love God and want to follow Jesus, what must we go and do?</p> | <p>PRAY "Jesus, thank you for your mercy. Help us show mercy to others. Amen."</p> |
| <p>Wk. of April 19: Lost and Found (Luke 15)</p> | <p>Read together Luke 15</p> | <p>Ask What are some of the things the father did when his son returned home? Why did he do them?</p> | <p>Practice memory verse: "There is joy before the angels of God over one sinner who repents." Luke 15:10</p> | <p>Ask How did the older brother feel when his brother returned and his father rejoiced? Would you have felt the same way?</p> | <p>PRAY "Amazing grace, how sweet the sound, that saved sinners like us. We once were lost but now are found, were blind but now we see. Amen."</p> |
| <p>Wk. of April 26: Debts and Debtors (Matthew 18)</p> | <p>Read together Matthew 18</p> | <p>Ask What did the first servant do to the servant who couldn't pay him back? What was wrong with that? What lesson is God trying to teach us?</p> | <p>Practice memory verse: "Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you." Ephesians 4:32</p> | <p>Ask What do we ask God to forgive in the Lord's prayer? And what do we tell him we will do to others? What should we do when we struggle to forgive others?</p> | <p>PRAY "Father in heaven, all our sins have been forgiven because of Jesus. Help us to treat others like you have treated us. Amen."</p> |
